All wrestlers will be grouped by age, weight, and skill level. Each group will learn new techniques taught by top college and high school coaches and wrestlers. Time will also be devoted to review, drilling, and live wrestling. Along with teaching great wrestling moves, each technique session will include free drilling time to give wrestlers a chance to practice new moves, and a competitive group activity to develop a sense of camaraderie and teamwork among campers. Wrestlers are encouraged to bring a pad and pen to write down any new moves learned.

Girls wrestling is growing at a rapid pace across the country. This camp will be run in conjunction with the Maryland Future Champions Wrestling Clinic for Boys. Girls will train with the boys and get the same great instruction from our top coaching staff.
